



**Advisory to Parents and Students  
on the Start of Classes on August 24, 2020**

While the Department of Education announced the deferment of the opening of classes on October 5, all classes in the Basic Education in the University of San Carlos will start on August 24, 2020 as scheduled. This decision is aligned with the DepEd Advisory dated August 15, 2020 that private schools are allowed to start the classes earlier than October 5, provided that distance learning modalities are used and there are no face-to-face classes to be conducted.

The University is ready to deliver the classes online using different learning management systems, e.g. *GENYO* for the Primary to Junior High School Levels at North and South Campuses, *Google Suite* for Montessori Academy and *Canvas* for the Senior High School. All preparations have been made, including the orientation to parents, so that we can officially start the classes on August 24, 2020.

May we have a more interactive learning experience through online learning that provides our students an opportunity to become more responsible learners!
