Admission requirements for incoming college freshmen

The following are required to take the qualifying examinations:

- 1. Original report card (Form 138) from Senior High School
- 2. Original birth certificate from the National Statistics Office (NSO)/Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)
- 3. Three (3) copies of 2×2 ID photographs (colored with white background)
- 4. Ballpen and pencil

Requirements for international student applicants

International students who wish to enroll in USC are required to visit the **Office of External Relations** for screening and evaluation of the following documents and secure a clearance from the same office before applying for admission.

- A. International students who graduated from schools outside the Philippines
 - 1. Informative copy of the Transcript of Records
 - 2. Diploma or certificate of graduation
 - 3. Police clearance
 - 4. Family register or birth certificate
 - 5. Photocopy of passport bio-page

These documents (all in English) must be authenticated with a red ribbon by the Philippine Embassy in the country of origin.

- B. International students who graduated from schools in the Philippines
 - 1. Certificate of graduation and report card
 - 2. Photocopy of ACR, I Card, and passport
 - 3. Photocopy of Special Study Permit
 - 4. Family register or birth certificate
 - 5. Photocopy of passport bio-page

- C. Filipino applicants who graduated from international schools outside the Philippines
 - 1. Informative copy of the Transcript of Records
 - 2. Diploma or certificate of graduation
 - 3. Police clearance or Certificate of Good Moral Character
 - 4. Original authenticated PSA birth certificate
 - 5. Photocopy of passport bio-page
 - 6. Philippine passport
 - 7. Certificate of recognition as Filipino (for applicants with dual citizenship)

The first three documents should be authenticated with a red ribbon by the Philippine Embassy in the country of origin.
